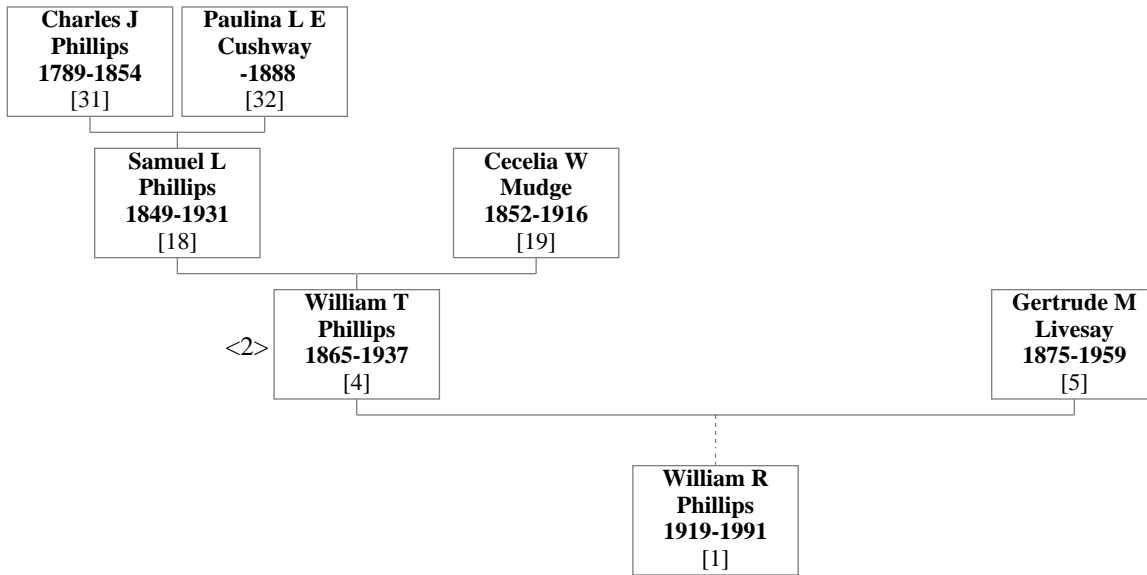

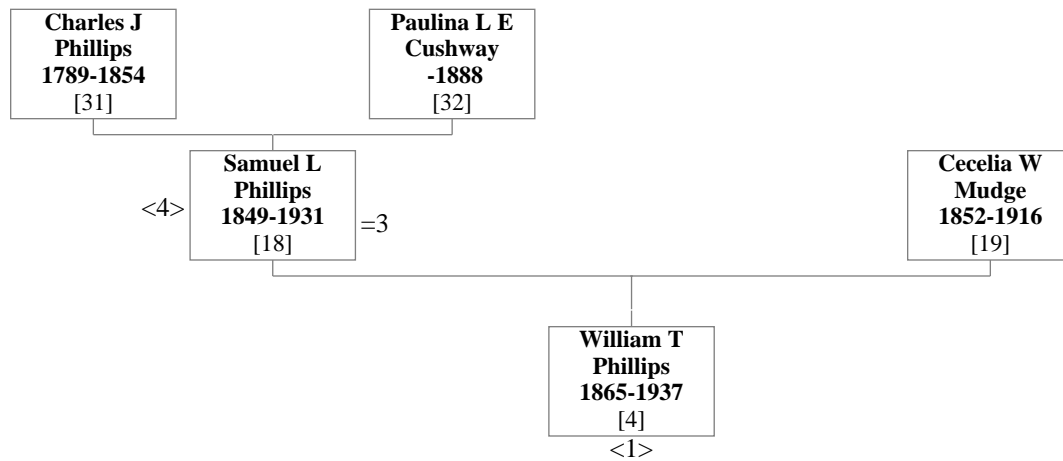

1. William T Phillips Obituary

SPOKANE SPOKESMAN-REVIEW, July 22, 1937, p. 13

His home was at W828 Glass. He was a member of Oriental Lodge No. 74 F & A. M and Scottish Rite bodies. He was a consulting engineer. Husband of Gertrude, at the home, father of William Richard Phillips of Spokane. Funeral Thurs., July 22, at 7:30 p.m. from the Alwin Chapel at the Hazen & Jaeger Funeral Home. Cremation will follow.

William Thadeus Phillips was born in Sandusky, Sanilac Co., Michigan on June 22, 1865 to Celia Mudge and Laddie J. Phillips per his marriage certificate. Gertrude Phillips, his widow, stated that "both she and her late husband had known Butch Cassidy, but that William T. Phillips was not the famous outlaw from Utah. Instead, she wrote, Phillips had been born and raised in an eastern state until he reached the age of 14 years, at which time (owing to dime novel influence) he ran away and headed for the Black Hills [along the South Dakota/Wyoming state line]. She wrote that Phillips had met Butch Cassidy at the time of the Johnson County War [1892 in Johnson County, Wyoming where the Hole-in-the-Wall hang-out for the robbers is located]. He thought he knew Cassidy very, very well" (Meadows, pages 115 & 123)

"Bob Phillips of Sandusky, Michigan said that his great grandfather, William J. Phillips reared (and may even have sired the imposter. He said his great grandparents lived across the street from Celia Mudge's family. Upon noticing that thirteen year old Celia was unable to provide proper care for her illegitimate son, Mr. and Mrs. Phillips - who had 15 children of their own - volunteered to take the baby in and give him a name (as well as the nickname "Butch") The boy lived with his adoptive family until he was fourteen, then went north to work in logging camps. After throwing an axe at a man during a fight, "Butch" Phillips lit out for the West, and his family never saw him again." (Meadows, pages 126 & 127)

Actually, Robert LeRoy Parker, better known as Butch Cassidy, was part of an infamous group of train and bank robbers, called the Wild Bunch.

William T Phillips, is believed to have been the son of Celia (Mudge) and "Laddie" or "Latta" Phillips, but William has not been found in the 1870-1930 Michigan Census. *Applies to: William Thadeus "Butch" Phillips⁴.*

The funeral services of Mrs. Celia Snell, who died on Saturday, April 8, were held from the M. E. church on Wednesday at 10 a. m. Interment was made in Elkland cemetery.

Celia Mudge was born October 20, 1852, at Monroe, Michigan. She was married to Hezekiah Snell at Tyre on February 1, 1873. The family have made their home at various places but for the past thirty years have lived in or near Cass City, so the deceased is no stranger to people of this vicinity. Mr. Snell died 13 years ago at Minden City but his body is interred in Elkland cemetery. Seven children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Snell, six of whom are living. They are Mrs. C. W. Houghton, Mrs. C. A. Fay and Mrs. John Atfield of Detroit, Mrs. W. R. Weber of Minden City, Mrs. A. H. Stone of Gilford and Roy Snell, who with the mother, had recently moved to the Levi Bardwell farm, where Mrs. Snell's death occurred.

Deceased has been a faithful attendant of the M. E. church and was a kind and willing neighbor and friend, who is mourned by a host of friends as well as her family. Two sisters, Mrs. Phillips and Mrs. Thibodeau, of Marine City survive her.

Her first name was Lind (probably Lina) per Michigan GENDIS death record for child William Phillips in 1871.
Applies to: Salina "Lina" Mudge²⁴.

18. Note: Salina Mudge was probably her given name.
Sabrina Mudge was 12 years old in the 1860 census.
Lina (Mudge) Phillips had 2 children not living in the 1900 census.
Other recorded names were Lena, Seelina, Gina, and Lind

Possibly, William T "Butch" Phillips used the name of his cousin,
William Phillips after his aunt Lina Phillips son had died in 1871.
